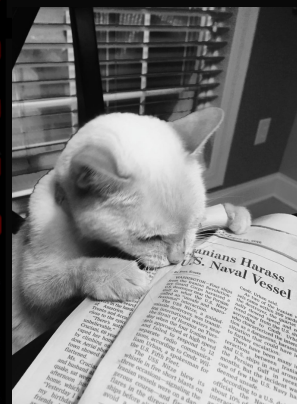
Who's In The Spotlight This Month?

Meet Dr. Colleen Scoda, DVM

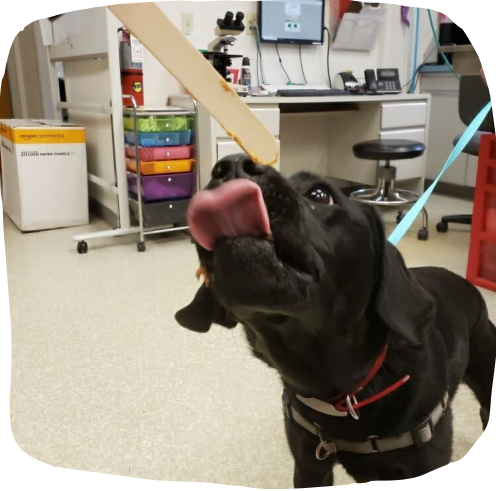

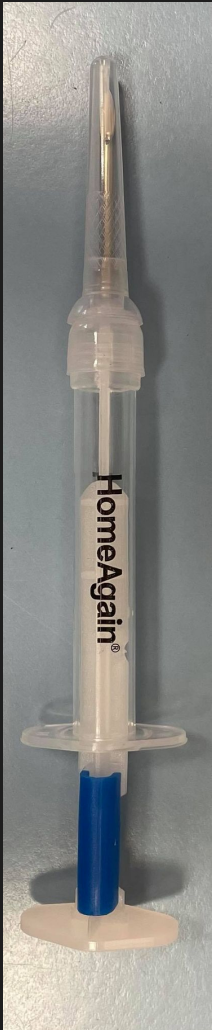
